

Trade Show Racing Simulator Competition Terms & Conditions

1. General

1.1 These Terms & Conditions ("Terms") govern the Racing Simulator Competition ("the Competition") taking place at our trade show stand ("the Stand").

1.2 The Competition is promoted by [IPS, UK, Unit 5, Railway Court, Doncaster, DN4 5FB] ("the Promoter").

1.3 By participating in the Competition, entrants agree to be bound by these Terms. The Promoter's decision is final in all matters relating to the Competition.

1.4 These Terms should be read alongside any additional instructions displayed at the Stand.

2. Eligibility

2.1 **Open participation:** Any visitor to the Stand is welcome to use the racing car simulator upon being invited by the Promoter, regardless of their organisation or role.

2.2 **Competition eligibility:** Entry into the Competition — and eligibility to appear on the official Leader Board and win a prize — is restricted to individuals who are employed in a **Local Authority** or a **Private Operator**.

2.3 Employees, contractors, and agents of the Promoter are not eligible to enter the Competition.

2.4 Participants must be aged 18 or over to enter the Competition.

2.5 By submitting a Competition entry, participants confirm they meet the eligibility criteria set out above. The Promoter reserves the right to verify eligibility and disqualify any entry that does not comply.

3. How to Enter

3.1 To enter the Competition, eligible participants must:

- Speak to a member of staff at the Stand to register their interest;
- Provide their name and organisation (Local Authority or Private Operator) for verification purposes;
- Complete their simulator run as directed by Stand staff.

3.2 Each eligible participant may attempt the simulator a maximum of **two times** during the event, with only their fastest recorded time counting towards the Leader Board.

3.3 No purchase is necessary to enter. No entry fee applies.

3.4 The Competition is open throughout the event on 20th May 2026 at Parkex, CBS Arena, subject to simulator availability.

4. The Competition & Leader Board

4.1 The Competition is based on lap time performance on the racing car simulator, using the designated track and settings as configured by the Promoter.

4.2 An official Leader Board will be displayed at the Stand, showing the fastest recorded times achieved by eligible Competition entrants.

4.3 The **Top 3 fastest times** on the Leader Board at the close of the Competition will be declared the winners.

4.4 The Leader Board will be updated in real time throughout the event. Positions may change until the Competition closes.

4.5 The Competition closes at **1459** on **20th May 2026**. No entries will be accepted after this time.

5. Winner Selection & Notification

5.1 Winners will be determined solely by their recorded lap time on the simulator. The three fastest eligible times at the close of the Competition will be ranked 1st, 2nd, and 3rd.

5.2 In the event of a tie, the participant who recorded their time first (earliest timestamp) will be ranked higher.

5.3 Winners will be announced at **3pm sharp** on the Stand on the final day of the event. Winners must be present on the Stand at 3pm to claim their prize. If a winner is not present at 3pm, the Promoter reserves the right to move down the Leader Board to the next eligible participant who is present on the Stand at that time. This process will continue until a winner who is present on the Stand is found and able to claim their prize.

5.4 The Promoter reserves the right to verify the eligibility of any winner prior to awarding a prize.

6. Prizes

6.1 The prizes for the Top 3 fastest times are as follows:

- **1st Place:** £100 Charity Donation & Bottle of Fizz
- **2nd Place:** £75 Charity Donation & Bottle of Fizz
- **3rd Place:** £50 Charity Donation & Bottle of Fizz

6.2 Prizes are non-transferable and no cash alternative will be offered.

6.3 The Promoter reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if circumstances require.

6.4 In addition to their prize, each of the Top 3 winners will receive a charitable donation of **£100 (1st Place), £75 (2nd Place), or £50 (3rd Place) — corresponding to their finishing position** made on their behalf to a charity of their choice. Winners must nominate their chosen charity at the time of the prize announcement (3pm on the Stand). The nominated charity must be a registered charity. Following Parkex, the Promoter will arrange a visit to present each winner with a cheque made payable to their nominated charity. The Promoter will make reasonable efforts to arrange the cheque presentation visit at a mutually convenient time.

7. General Rules & Conduct

7.1 All participants must follow the instructions of Stand staff at all times.

7.2 The simulator must be used in a safe and responsible manner. Any participant behaving in an unsafe, disruptive, or inappropriate manner may be disqualified and asked to leave the Stand.

7.3 Tampering with the simulator, the Leader Board, or another participant's entry is strictly prohibited and will result in immediate disqualification.

7.4 The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any technical failures, errors, or interruptions affecting the simulator or Leader Board during the event.

7.5 The Promoter reserves the right to amend, suspend, or cancel the Competition at any time without prior notice, in the event of circumstances beyond its reasonable control.

7.6 These Terms are governed by the laws of England and Wales.

8. Data & Privacy

8.1 Personal data (name and organisation) collected at the point of entry will be used solely for the purposes of administering the Competition and verifying eligibility.

8.2 Data will be held securely and will not be shared with third parties without consent, except where required by law.

8.3 For full details of how the Promoter handles personal data, please refer to the Promoter's Privacy Policy, available on request.

8.4 Participants may request deletion of their data following the conclusion of the Competition by contacting the Promoter at [contact email/address].

9. Photography & Social Media

9.1 The Promoter may take photographs of winners on the Stand at the time of the prize announcement for use on social media and for marketing and promotional purposes in connection with the Competition and the Promoter's business.

9.2 By participating in the Competition, winners acknowledge and consent to their photograph being taken and used in this way.

9.3 Winners have the right to opt out of being photographed and having their image used for social media or marketing purposes. This will not affect their prize or their status as a winner in any way.

9.4 To opt out, winners should inform a member of Stand staff at the time of the prize announcement (3pm on the final day of the event). The Promoter will respect all opt-out requests made at that time.

9.5 Photographs will only be used in connection with the Competition and the Promoter's business and will not be sold or passed to third parties for unrelated commercial purposes.
